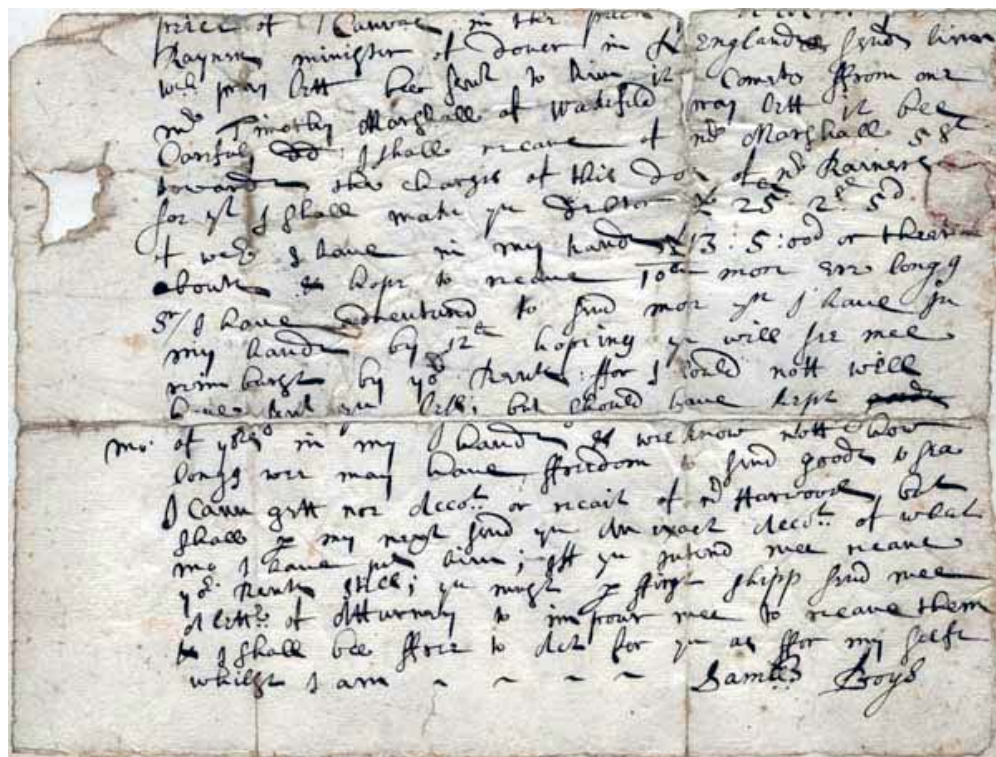

Letter fragment from Samuel Boyes (Job Lane is presumed addressee) regarding money matters

 find mor [?] I have in my hand by 12th hoping you

 well have sent you less but should have kept money
 of yours in my hand and we know not how long we
 may have freedom to send goods at sea. I can get no
 account or receipt of Mr Harwood but shall by my
 next find you an exact account of what money I have
 paid him. Iff you intend me receive your rent still,
 you must by first shipp send mee a letter of Attorney
 to impower me to receive them & I shall bee sure to
 act for you as for my self whilst I am
