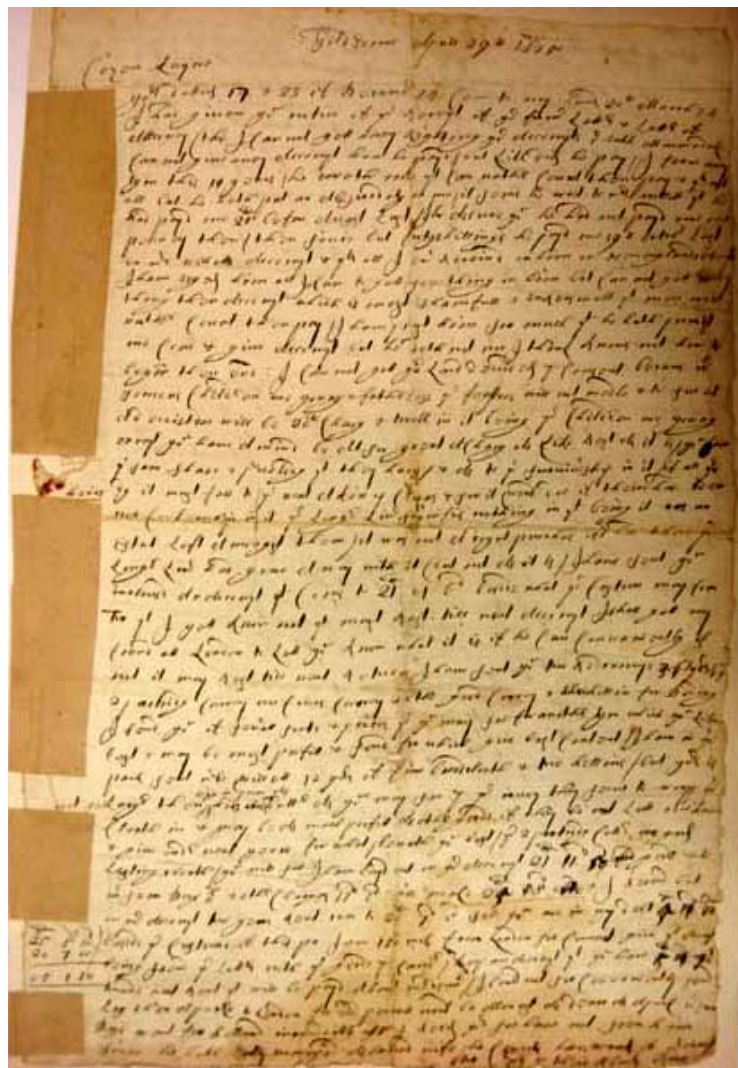

Letter to Job Lane from John Dickinson regarding shipment of linen



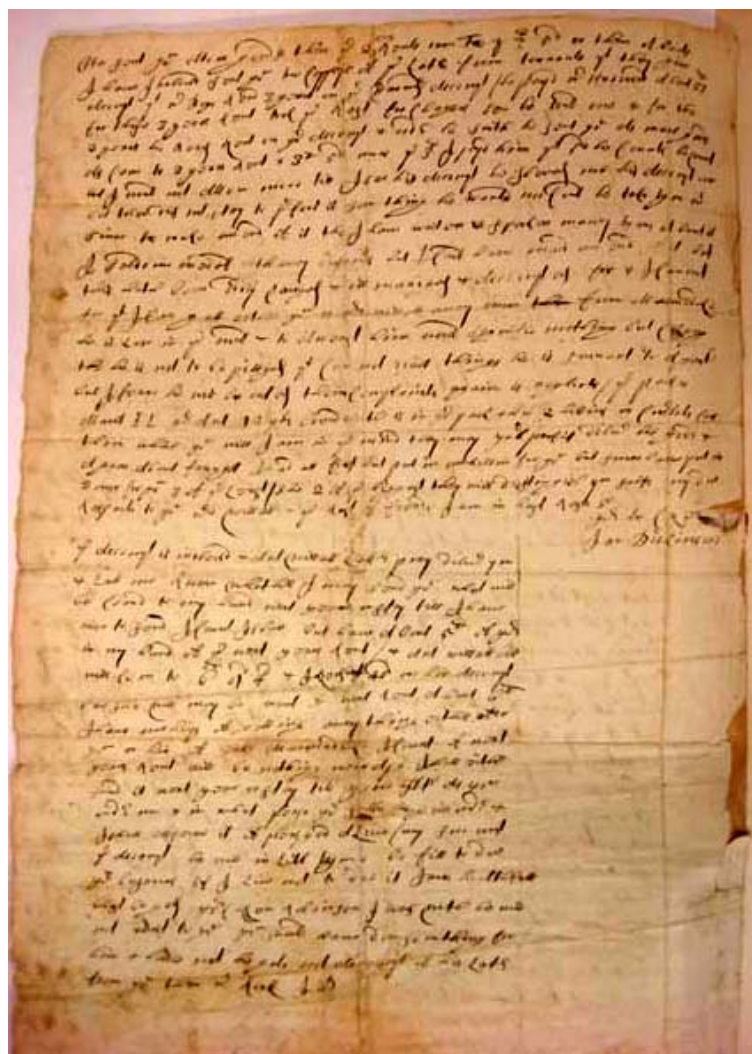

Yours dated 17 & 23 of December 74 came to my hand 20th March 74. I had given your notice of your receipt of your friends letters and letters of attorney (tho I cannot gett aney righting your accounts) Unkl Marmaduke cannot give any account how he paid but [Lilldiss] he pay / I found aney ty in this 19 years/ he vexeth me yt can not he count then pay & yt nt all but he hath put an absurdety on me/ it sems he wnt to Mrs Millitt yt he had paid me 20 “w?” before Augst last/ Jhn assure you he had nt payd no one penney then/ then since but forty shillings he payd one 19th october last in only? willetts accompt & yts all I ever received on him on New England accompts I have urges him all I can to gett something on him but cannot gett any thing then accompt which is most shamefull & unreasonable yet men will natlll? count than pay/ I have prest him soo much yt he hath promysd me com & give accompt but he doth not mr? I think knows not how to begin then end: I cannot gett your land d evid ers by consent because Mr Simons children are young and fatherless the feestoos will not medle & h su ?? administration will be 20^w chang & troubl in it being the children are young except you have a mind be at soo great a chang its like rest as it is/ you have the sam share & priveledg that they have/ & as to the survivorship in it/ if all the heirs dy it must fall to the next a kin & ciries & sue it cwould doo
