 the interest of that justly left by at 16: $\frac{2}{3}$ p^{er} cent. . 2:04:00
 yo^r brother Lane paid us in severall payments . £ 78:11:00
 the interest of his said summs, at 16: $\frac{2}{3}$ p^{er} cent. is £ 13:00:00
