 pounde ten shilings too Leave of work

 mied at Maldin: which he sayd was then  
 Mistris Cogings: wore too the soueld: and  
 of wear wiver Leagis wear too  
 be payd out of the mill: and that Job  
 Lane wore too: that the mill Incase he  
 might have done the work which we had  
 Ingaged too dooe: As witnis ouer hands  
 of 6 of Aprill: 1663
