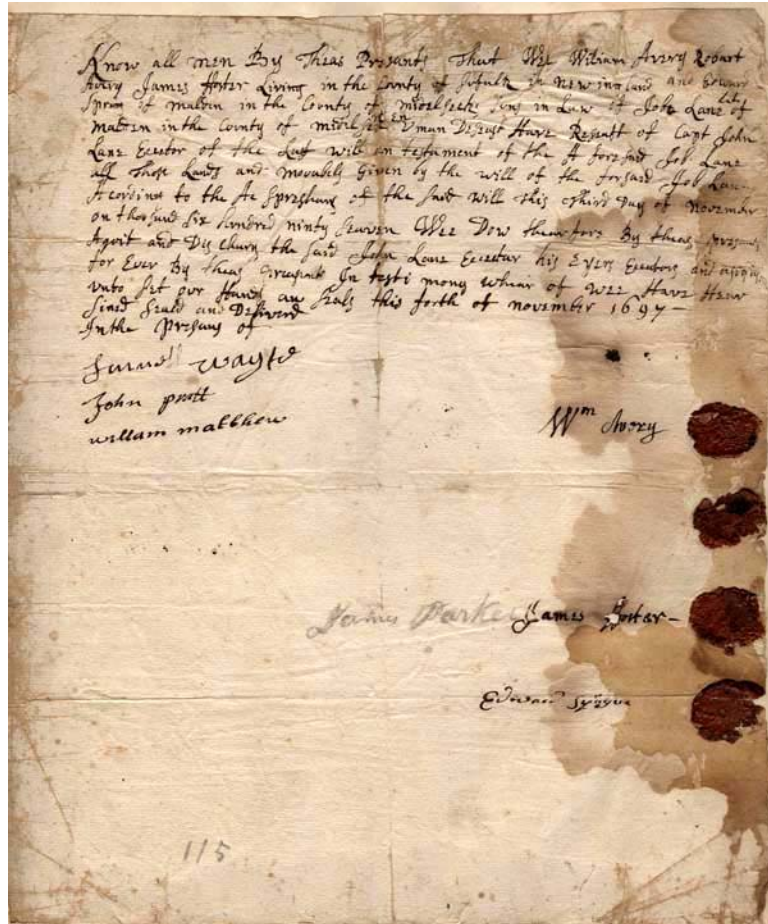


#50 November 4, 1697

Discharge of John Lane as executor of Job Lane's estate



Know all men by this presents that wee William Avery, Robert Avery, James Foster living in the county of Suffolk in New England and Edward Sprague of Malden in the county of Midelseck; sons in law of Job Lane late of Malden in the county of Midelsecks yeoman[?] deseast have reseaft [received] of Capt John Lane Exector of the last will and testament of the aforesaid Job Lane all those lands and movables given by the will of the forsaid Job Lane Acording to the Acspreshuns [expressions] of the said will this third day of November one thousand six hundred ninty seven. Wee Dow [do] therefore by theas presents aquit and discharg the said John Lane Exectar his eyes [heirs] exectors and asigns for ever by theas presents In testimony whiar of wee have hear unto set our hands and seals this forth of November 1697
