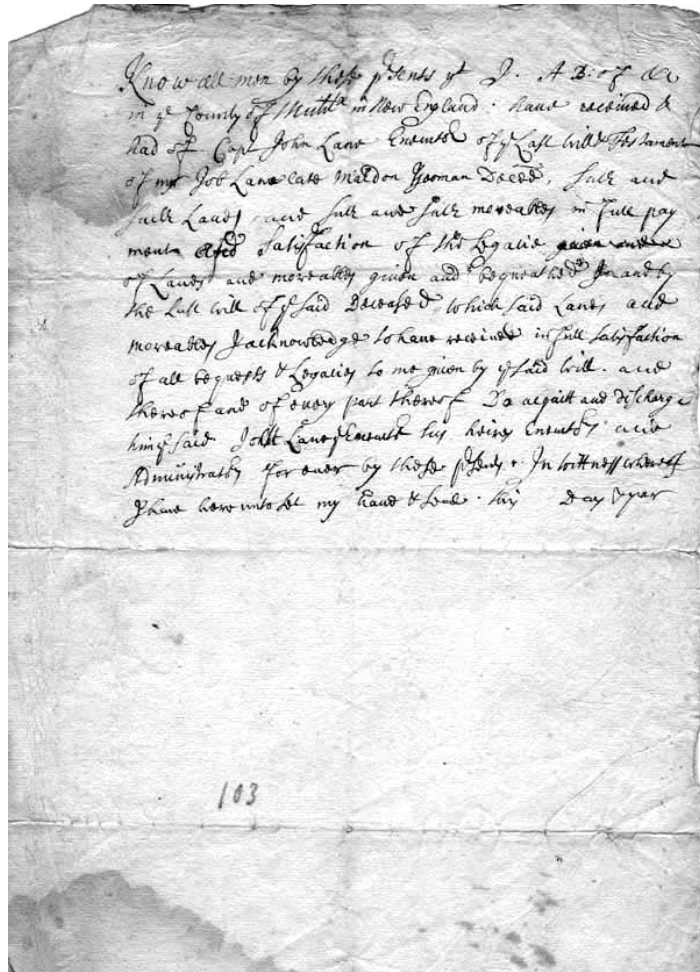


#54 No date, but most likely 1697 after Job Lane's death Receipt (unsigned draft) attesting to having received everything given by Job Lane's will



Know all men by these presents that I A B of [illegible] in the county of Midd'x in New England have received & had of Capt John Lane executor of the last will & testament of mr Job Lane Malden yoeman dec'd full and fair lands and full and fair movables in full payment and satisfaction of ___ ___ and of lands and moveables given and bequeathed In and by the last will of the said deceased, which said lands and moveables I acknowledge to have received in full satisfaction of all bequests & legalley to me given by the said will. and thereof and every part thereof Do acquitt and discharge him ye said John Lane ye Executor his having entrusted[?] and administrated[?] for ever by those present & in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal this [blank] Day & [blank] Year
