London 11th March 1698

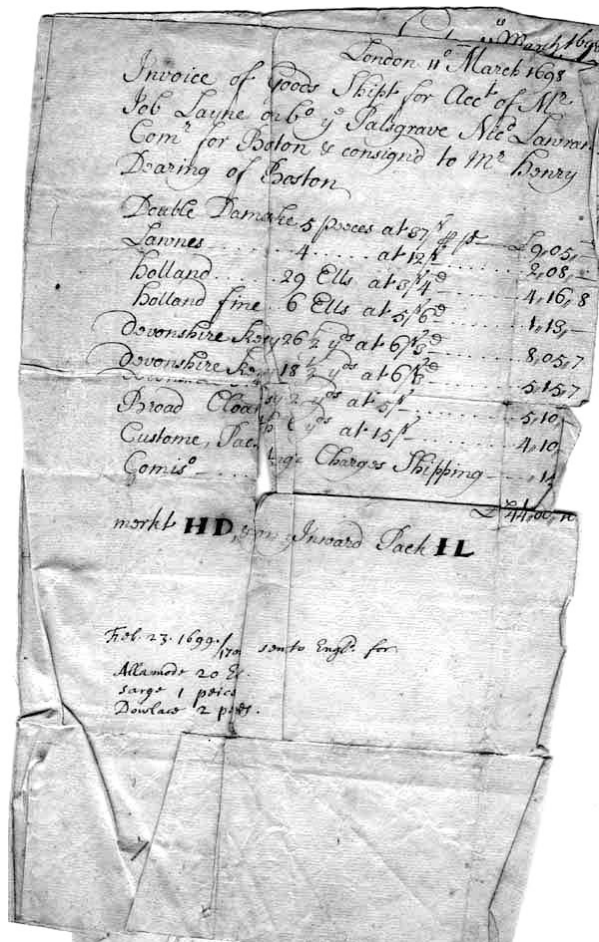

By direction from my father John Dickinson of Gildersome I have shipped for your Acct onto the Palsgrave, Nic[holas] Laurance Com[mander] consigned Mr Henery Dearing a parcell of goods am't to 44:00:10 pounds when of you have Invoice hereof. By this ship or the next you will hear from my father himself, have the state of your acct w/ him for the future. It will be more easy both for you & him [*?rip in the document: that you app...d Som...]* in London by letter of Acct, receive the money for you from him as it got in & to give discharge from tyme to tyme about which you may expect to hear further from himself-----
