Yours I rec'd dated the 23rd Feb: 99—With an account that you had received the goods sent in March 98 amounting to £44..-10s How it happens my letter [?myso arwy] I cannot tell. I have sent you 2 letters since March 98 & the state of the account betwixt us in each: A copy whereof I now send you herein included; Least the other should miscarry.

You ordered me in your last to send some of the [due ?r] in Allamode but it being now dear I have sent you other goods to the vullue of 12..14..-4 : Amount wherein is underwritt.

Pray let me know as soon as you receive the goods & let me have directions how to send goods & letters so as they may come safely to your hands.
