Debt obligation owed by John Lane (3?) to Cosen Mathew Whipple of Ipswich (assume this is John Lane 3)

Know all men by these presents that I Maj John Lane of Bilaracke in the county of midel six in the provence of the masatuos bay in new england am holden and formly bound and abliged to cosen mathew whipple of Ipswich in the county of Essex in the provens above sd in the sum of thertean pounds of good corant lawfull ^{money} of this provence of New England to be pade to the said mathew whipple his cartin attorney executors or administrators or asians to the wich payment wall and truly to be made I bind my self my executors & administrators formly by these presents sealed with my seal dated

Sept 29 1714

The condishon of this obligation is such that if the above bounded John Lane his executors administrators or any of them du wall and truly pay or ca^use to be paid unto the above named ~~Matthew~~ the said mathew whipple his ex^t adm^{or} or assigns the just som of six pounds eighteen shilings and sixpens of lik lawfull money of this provence at or before the 29 of sept 1715 at or in the new dwelling hous of the sd mathew whipple situate in Ipswich afore sad without fraud or deceit then this obligation shall be void also this same to stand and remain in full fors effect & vartue be fore syning seiling the word money is enterd lined between the 4 & 5 line
