Unsigned agreement by the heirs of Samuel Ruggles (including Job Lane) for division of his land in Hardwick, plus a "true copy" of part of the agreement

(The following is a fragment written in a different hand that seems to refer to the same transaction)

Agreed upon by the partners of the Land belonging to the heirs of Mr Sam^l Ruggles, Land in Hardwich that **Joseph Stevens** shall have one half of it Lot No 24 the Northwest corner joyning upon the turn of Swift River and half the Lot No. 32 in the ninth Range lying south from Land belonging to Col Lamb and that **Job Lane** shall hold half of No 24 and half of Lot No 32 of which Joseph Stevens aforst had the other part.
