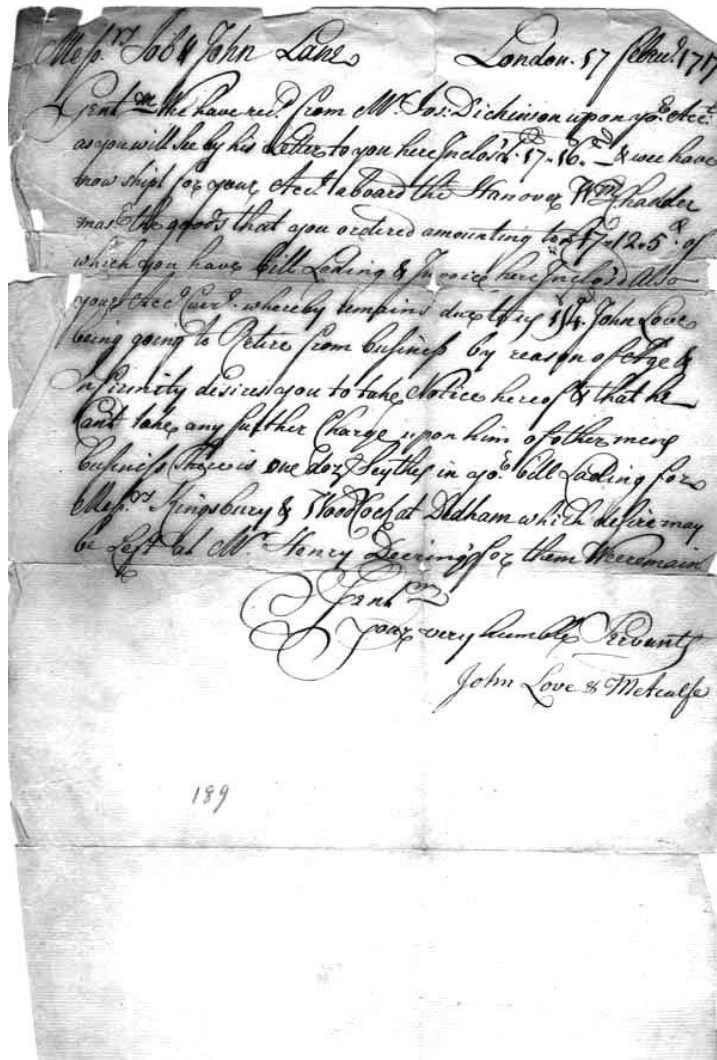

London. 7 febr.

Gent^m We have rec^d from Mr Jos. Dickinson upon yo^r Acc^t as you will see by his Letters to you here Inclosed 17..16.-- & wee have now shipt for your Acc^t aboard the Stanover W^m Chadder mas^r & the goods that you ordered amounting to 17..12..5 of which you have bill lading & Invoice her inclosed Also your Acc^o Curr^t whereby remains due to us [1/4] John Love being going to Retire from business by reason of Age & Infirmitie desires you to take Notice hereof & that he can't take any further charge upon him of other mens business There us one doz Scythes in yo^r bill lading for Mes^r Kingsbury & Woodcock at Dedham which desire may be left at Mr Henry Deering for them Wee remain
