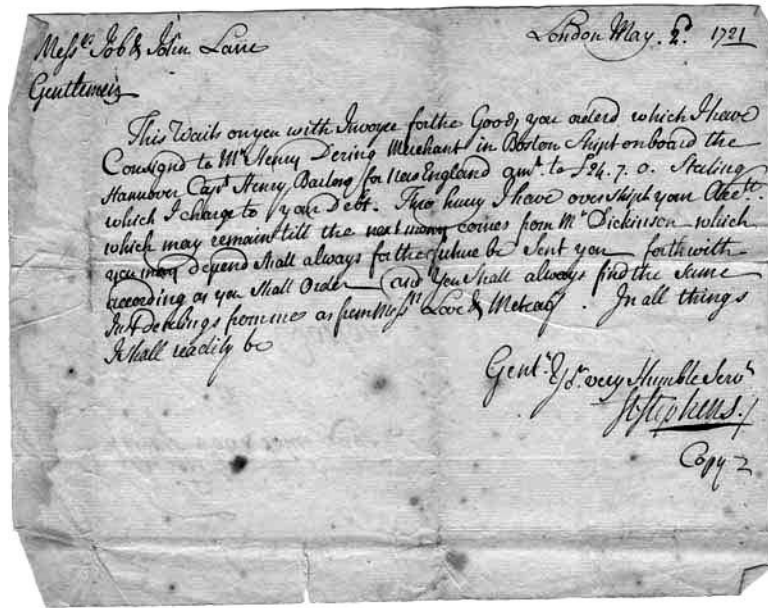

This waits on you with Invoice for the Goods you ordered which I have Consign'd to Mr Henry Dering Merchant in Boston Shipt onboard the Hanover Capt Henry Barlow for New England amt to £24.7.0 Sterling which I charge to your Debt. Thru hurry I have overshipped your Acct which may remain till the next money comes from Mr Dickinson which you may depend shall always for the future be Sent you forthwith according as you shall oeder and you shall always find the same just dealings from me as from Mess^{rs} Love & Metcalf.
