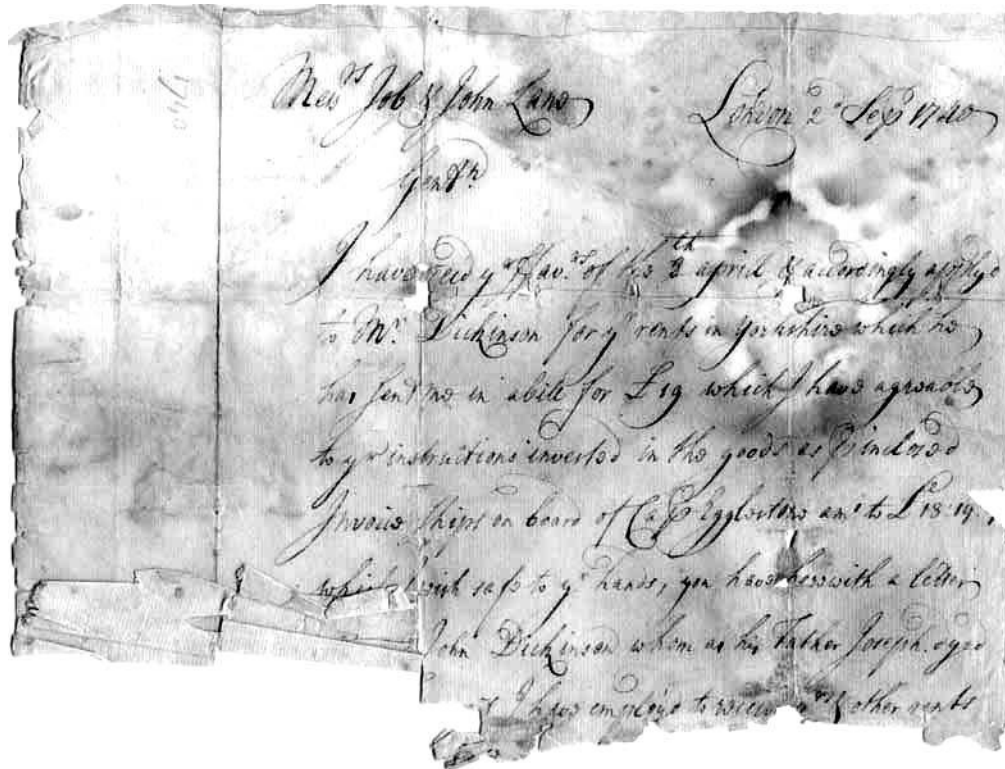

Fragment of letter to Job and John Lane

Mess^{rs} Job & John Lane

London 2^d Sept 1740

Gent^m

I have recd y^r fav.^{as} of the 8th Aprill I accordingly applyd to Mr Dickinson for y^r rents in Yorkshire which he has sent me in a bill for £19 which I have agreeable to y^r instructions invested in the goods as p[er] inclosed shipt on board of Capt Egglestons am^o to £18:19:9 which I wish safe to y^r hands, you have herewith a letter from Mr John Dickinson whom as his Father Joseph dyed [?t... ?ast] I have employ'd to receive y^{rs} & other rents to which *(rest is missing)*
