

to attend you're much ob^d your

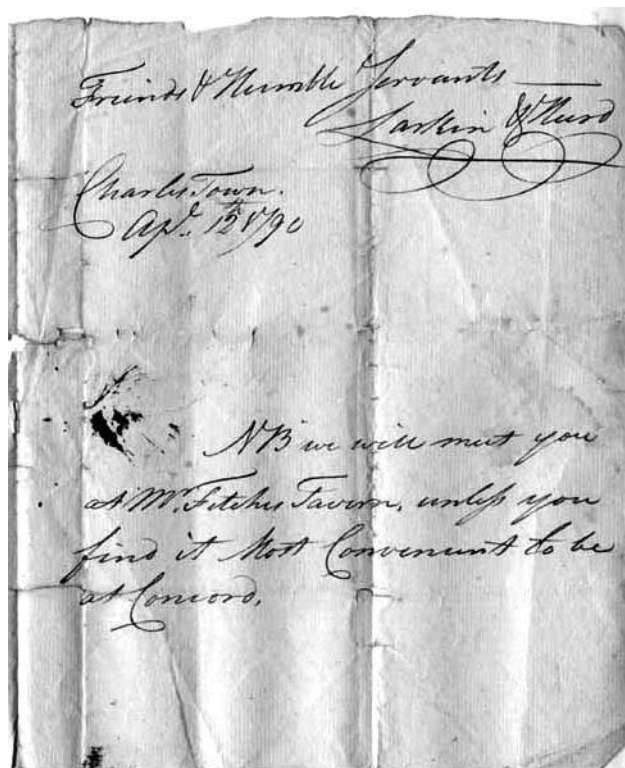
