 was three foot deep But when I got home there had been no snow
 for three weeks & but a little all winter---
 I got home well I sold chief of my Leather our folks was very
 much concerned about me not knowing what was the matter
 Father & Mother are well & send their love to you all: Give my
 love to Lydia sarah Hannah Job Mollie Bethieh and Luke and all
 friends, especially John & Matthew Fitch
 All our folks send their love to you---
