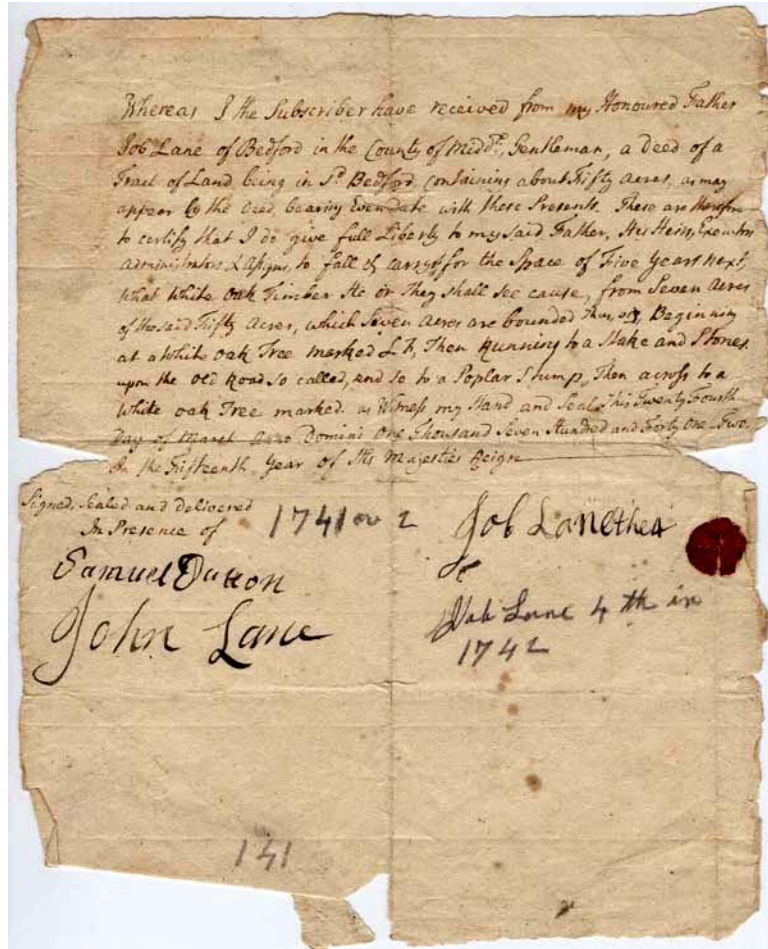


#169 March 24, 1741/2

Deed for right to take wood for period of 5 years



Whereas I the subscriber have received from my Honoured Father Job Lane of Bedford in the county of Midd^x, Gentleman, a deed of a tract of land being in sd Bedford containing about fifty acres, as may appear by the deed, bearing even date with these presents. These are therefore to certify that I do give full liberyt to by said Father, his heirs, executors, administrators & assigns to fall & carry of for the space of five years next what white oak timber he or they shall see cause, from seven acres of the said fifty acres, which seven acres are bounded [?there, as] beginning at a white oak tree marked L F, then running to a stake and stones upon and old road so called, and to a poplar stump, then across to a white oak tree marked. as Witness my hand and seal this Twenty Fourth Day of March Anno Domini one Thousand Seven Hundred and Forty one-two In the Fifteenth year if the Majesties Reign-----
