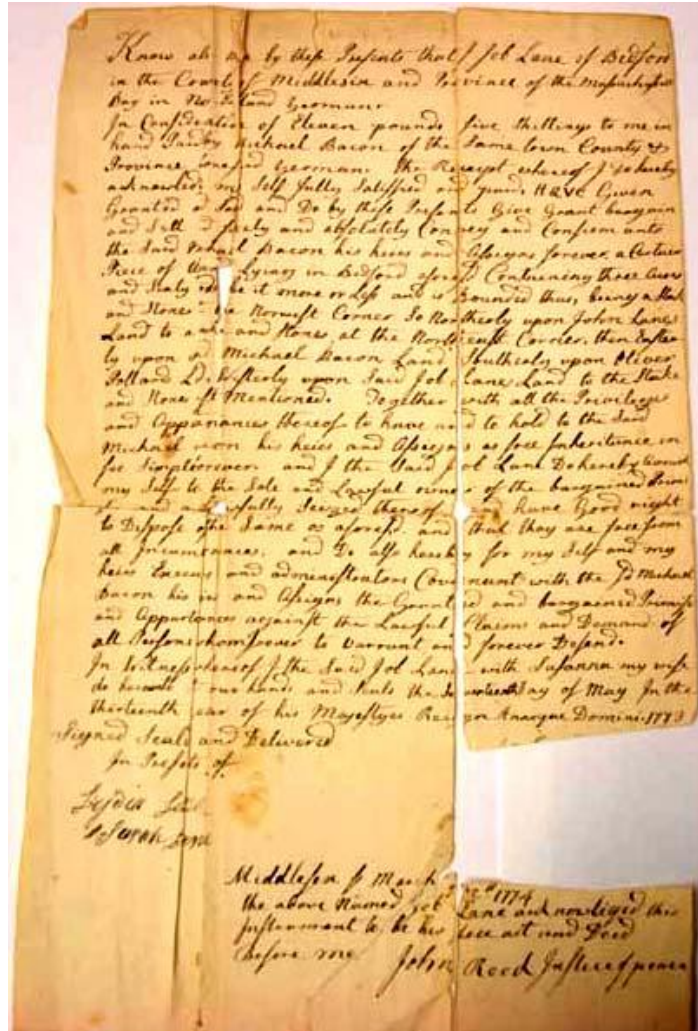


#173 May 13, 1773

Deed for Bedford land sale, Job Lane to Michael Bacon



Know all men by their presents that I Job Lane of Bedford in the County of Middlesex and Province of the Massachusetts Bay in New England Yeoman.

In Consideration of Eleven pounds five shillings to me in hand paid by Michael Bacon of the same town County & Province aforesaid yeoman. The Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge my self fully satisfied and paid, have given granted and sold and Do by these presents give grant bargain and sell and freely and absolutely convey and confirm unto the said Michael Bacon his heirs and assigns forever; a certain piece of upland lying in Bedford aforesd containg three acres and sixty rods be it more or less and is bounded thus, being a stake and stones in the Northwest corner so Northerly upon John Lanes land to a stacke and stones at the North east corner then Easterly upon said Michael Bacon land Southerly upon Oliver Pollard land, Westerly upon said Job Lane land to the Stake and Stones first mentioned. Together with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof to have and to hold to the said Michael Bacon his heirs and assigns as free inheritance in use simple forever. and I the Said Job Lane do hereby avouch myself to be the sole and lawful owner of the bargained premises and am lawfully seized thereof and have good right to dispose of the same as aforesd and that they are free from all incumbrances and Do also hereby for my self and my heirs executors and administrators Covenant with the sd Michael Bacon his heirs and assigns the granted and bargained premises and appurtenances against the lawful claims and demands of all

persons whomsoever to warrant and forever defend. In witness  
whereof the said Job Lane with Susanna my wife do hereunto set  
our hands and seals the seventeenth day of May in the thirteenth  
year of his Majesties reign Anno Domini 1773
