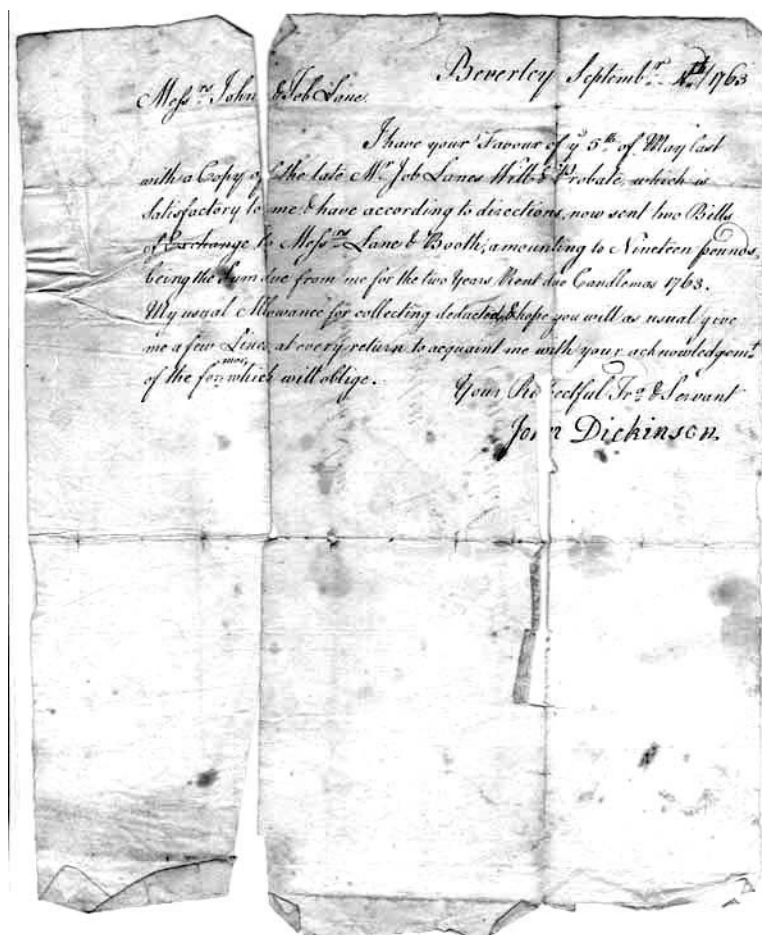


#184 September ? 1763

Letter from John Dickinson (has received copy of Mr. Job Lane's will and probate)



Beverly September 4th 1763

Mess^{rs} John and Job Lane

I have your Favour of y^e 5th of May last with a Copy of the late Mr. Job Lanes Will & Probate which is Satisfactory to me. & have according to directions now sent two Bills of Exchange to Mess^{rs} Lane & Booth, amounting to Nineteen pounds, being the Sum due from me for the two years Rent due Candlemas 1763. My usual Allowance for collecting deducted. & hope you will as usual give me a few Lines at every return to acquaint me with your acknowledgem^t of the former which will oblige.
