Letter from Samuel Gilson, Concord to Job Lane

Concord the 25 of March 1786  
 To Brother Lane Sir this is to let you know that  
 I am well at this time hoping that these lines will  
 find you so  
 Sir I heard from mis Gilson since she got home  
 and she writes that she got home very well only  
 she had one fault of the horse but did not hurt  
 her ~~hand~~ she said that she found the children  
 all well and other thing as well as she ~~expected~~  
 likewise she writes to me that if I could  
 make out what I was talking of when you  
 was hear the people would be in a mind to  
 me out by what they said at the Town meeting  
 and Sir I want you should be so good as to go  
 to my Brother Furbursh and tell him that I  
 want to see him as quick as he can come and see  
 me tell him that I should be glad if he would come  
 back with you ~~if you~~ Sir if you cant go be  
 so good as to come and see me hear  
 But if you go to Andovour I want you should  
 go as soon as you get this letter and make  
 him come back with you and if you go and  
 he cant come I should be glad if you will ride  
 up hear him Evening and see me turn over

To Brother Lane Sir this is to let you know that I am well at this time hoping that these lines will find you so

But if you go to Andovour I want you should go as soon as you get this letter and make him come back with you and if you go and he cant come I should be glad if you will ride up hear some evening and see me turn over

or if you could come before you went I should  
be glad but if not sit upon his coming of write  
you and tell him that I expected he would come and  
see me before now for I have not see him for on  
five months for you may tell him that the  
people have a mind to let me out if I can secure  
for a certain part with what is due on the  
rates and if any body should undertake  
for me with my securing them and not  
without for I think that there may be some  
body found that will under take the matter  
if I could get any body to spend a little time for  
me and I should be willing to pay them for  
there time if I could get them to do any thing  
so humane at this time

or if you could come before you went I should be glad but if not sit upon his coming as with you and tell him that I expected he would come and see me before now for I have not see him for on five months sir you may tell him that the people have a mind to let me out if I can secure for a certain part with what is due on the Rates and I want somebody should undertake for me with my securing them and not without for I think that there may be somebody found that will under take the matter if I could get anybody to spend a little time for me and I should be willing to pay them for there time if I could get them to do anything so humane [Humane??] at this time
