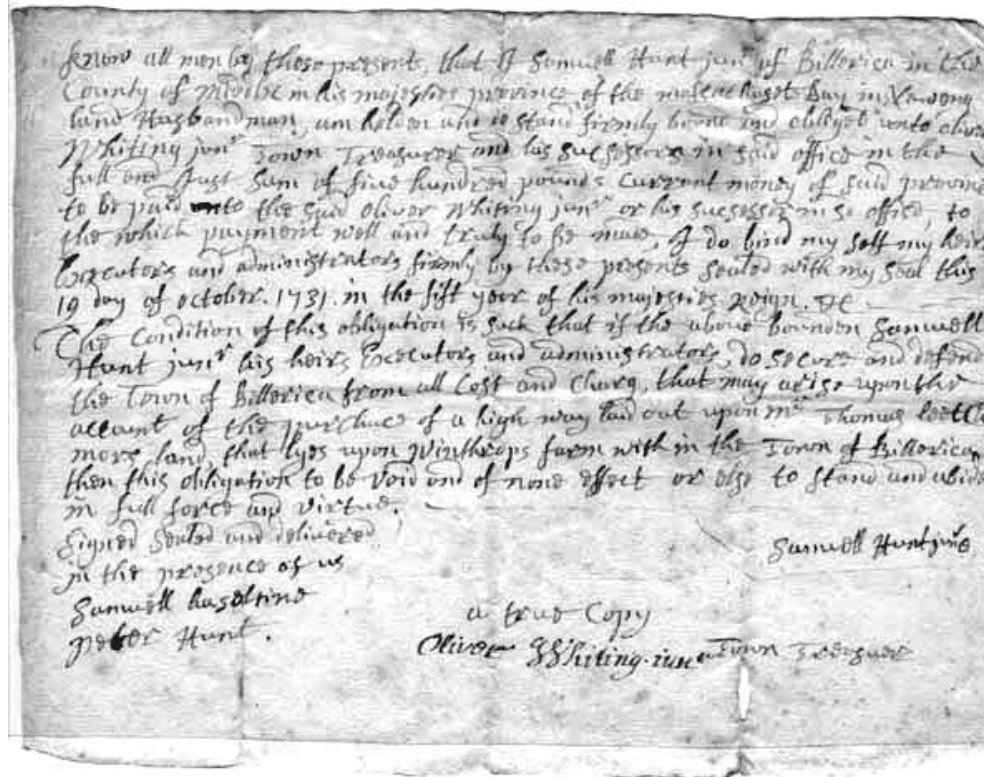


#209 October 19, 1731

Bond between Samell Hunt Junior and Oliver Whiting, Billerica, Town Treasurer for laying out of highway



Know all men by these presents that I Samuell Hunt jun^r of Billerica in the county of Middlesex in his majesties province of the Massachusetts Bay in New England Husbandman, am holden and do stand firmly bound and obliged unto Oliver Whiting jun^r Town Treasurer and his successors in said office in the full and just sum of five hundred pounds currant money of said province to be paid unto the said Oliver Whiting or his successer in sd office, to the which payment well and truly to be made, I do bind my self my heirs executors and administrators firmly by these presents sealed with my seal this 19 day of October 1731 in the fift year of his majesties reign. & The condition of this obligation is such that if the above bounden Samuell Hunt jun^r his heirs executors and administrators do secure and defend the town of Billerica from all cost and charg, that may arise upon the account of the purchase of a high way laid out upon M^r Thomas Whittemors land , that lyes upon Winthrops farm with in the town of Billerica then this obligation to be void and of none effect or else to stand and abifde in full force and virtue signed sealed and delivered
