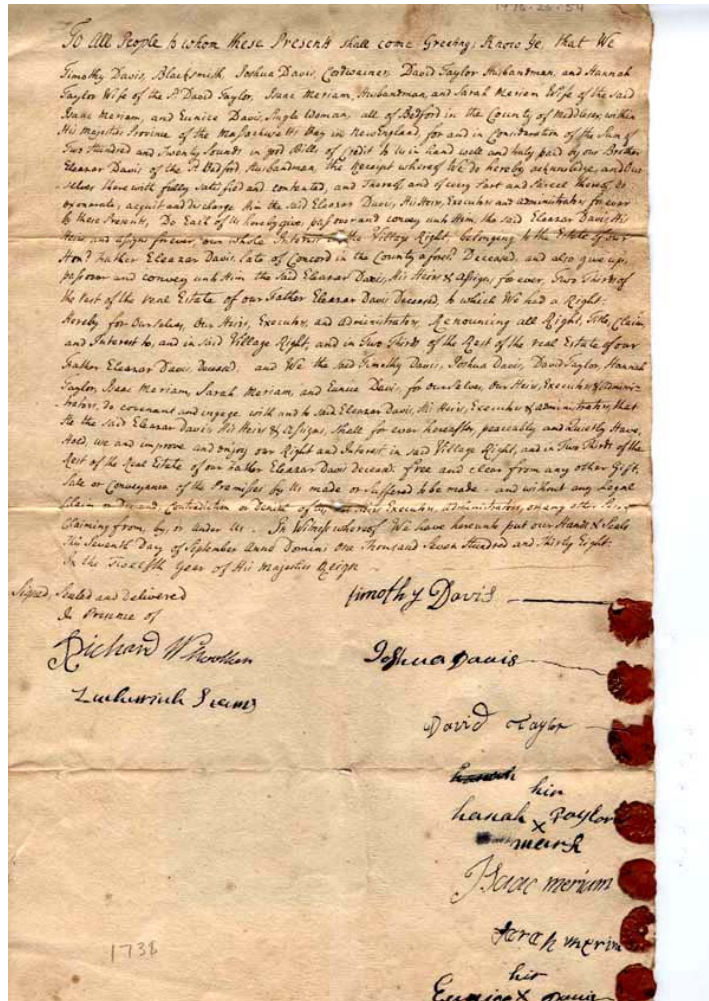

To all People to whom these Presents shall come Greeting; Know Ye that We Timothy Davis, Blacksmith, Joshua Davis, Cordwainer, David Taylor, Husbandman, and Hannah Taylor Wife of the s^d David Taylor, Isaac Meriam, Husbandman, and Sarah Meriam Wife of the said Isaac Meriam, and Eunice Davis, Single Woman, all of Bedford in the County of Middlesex within His Majesties Province of the Massachusetts Bay in New England, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Twenty Pounds in good Bills of credit to be in hand well and truly paid by our Brother Eleazor Davis of the s^d Bedford, Husbandman, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, and Ourselves Here with fully satisfied and contented, and thereof, and of every Part and Parcel thereof, do exonerate, acquit and discharge Him the said Eleazor Davis, His Heirs, Executors and administrators for ever by these Presents, Do Each of us hereby give, pass over and convey unto Him, the said Eleazor Davis, His Heirs and assigns forever, our whole Interest in the Village Right, belonging to the Estate of our Hon.^d Father Eleazor Davis late of Concord in the conty a fores^d Deceased and also give up passover and convey unto Him the said Eleazor Davis, His Heirs & Assigns for ever, Two Thirds of the rest of the real Estate of our Father Eleazor Davis deceased to which We had a right: Hereby for Ourselves, Our Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, Renouncing all Right, Title, Claim and Interest to and in said Village Right, and in Two Thirds of the Rest of the real Estate of our Father Eleazor Davis, deceased and We the said Timothy Davis, Joshua Davis, David Taylor, Hannah Taylor, Isaac Meriam, Sarah Meriam and Eunice Davis, for our selves, our Heirs, Executors & Administrators, do covenant and ingage with and to said Eleazor Davis, His Heirs, Executors & Administrators, that the said Eleazor Davis, His Heirs & Assigns, shall for ever hereafter, peaceably and Quietly

Have, Hold, use and improve and enjoy our Right and Interest in said Village Right and in Two Thirds of the Rest of the Real Estate of our Father Eleazor Davis, deceased, free and clear from any other gift, sale of conveyance of the Premises by us made or suffered to be made – and without any Leyne, Claim or demand, contradiction or denial of [?hole in paper] Heirs, Executors, Administrators, or any other Person claiming from, by, or under us. In Witness whereof We have hereunto put our Hands & Seals This Seventh Day of September Anno Domini, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty Eight: In the Twelfth Year of His Majesties Reign

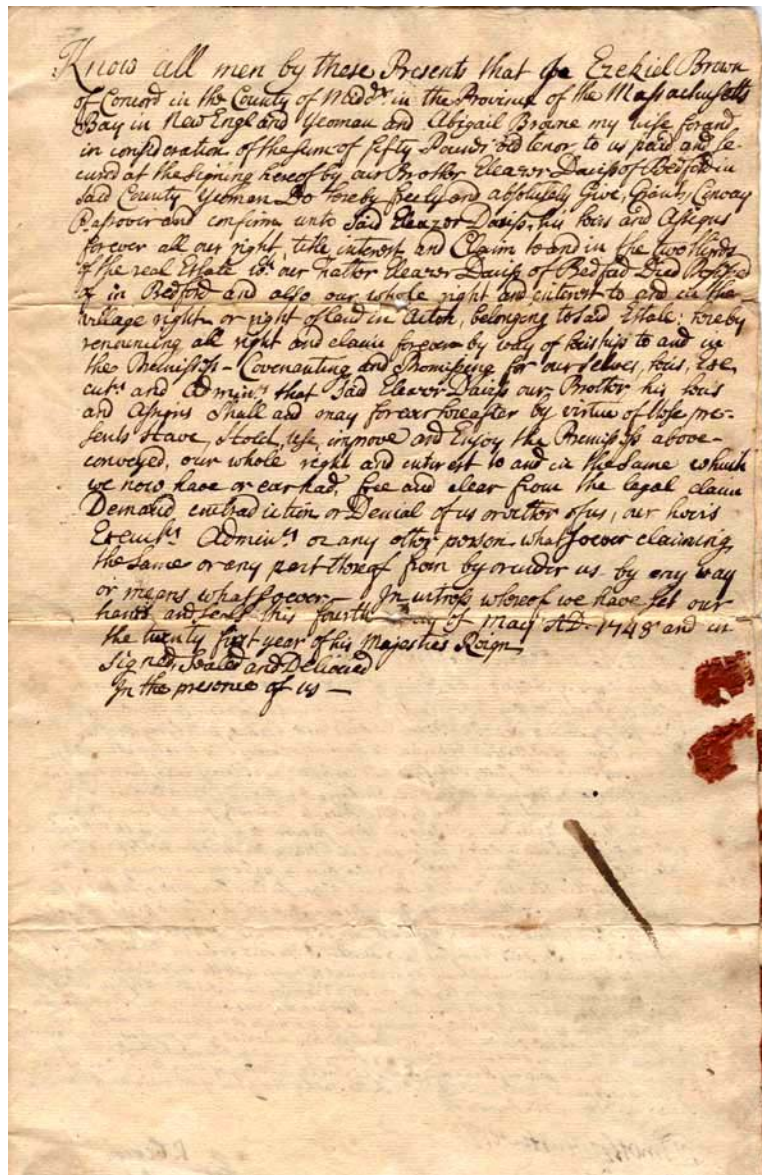

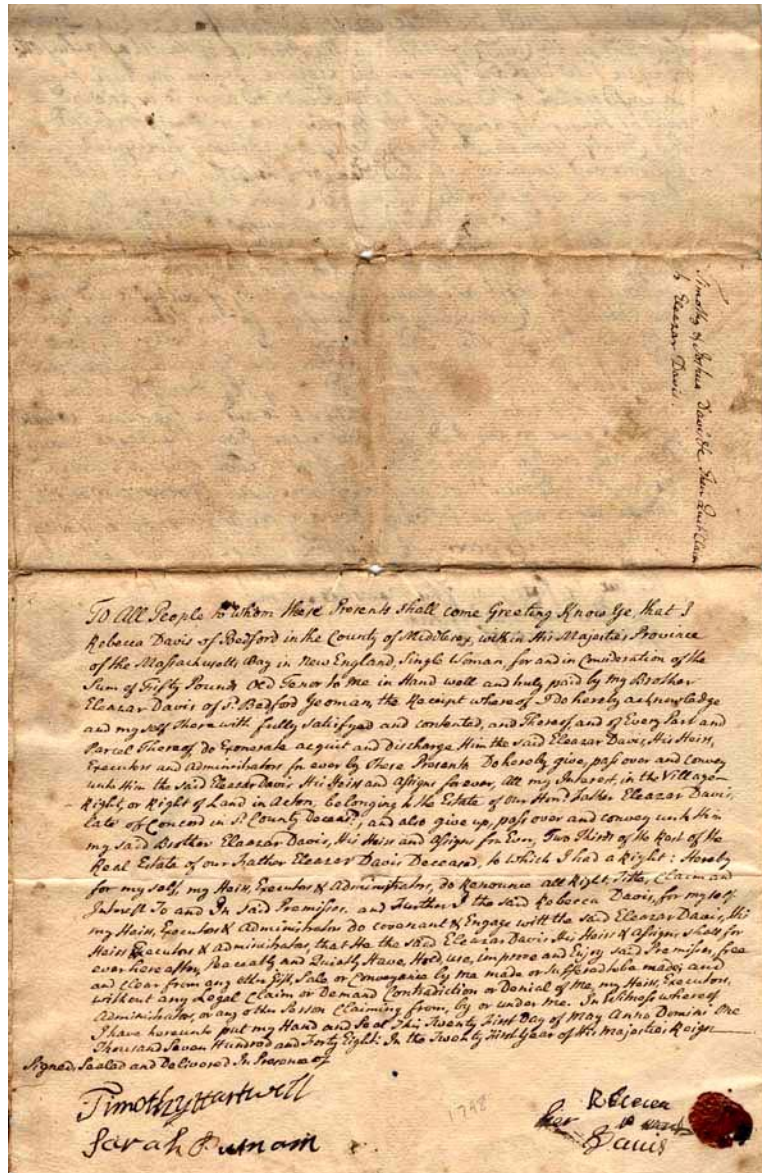

Know all men by these Presents that I Ezekiel Brown of Concord in the County of Midd^x in the Province of the Massachusetts Bay in New England Yeoman and Abigail Browne my wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds old tenor to us paid and secured at the signing hereof by our Brother Eleazor Davis of Bedford in said County yeoman Do hereby freely and absolutely give, grant, convey, forever all our right, title, interest and claim to and in the two thirds of the Real Estate w^{ch} our Father Eleazor Davis of Bedford Died passed of in Bedford and also our whole right and interest to and in the village right or right of land in Acton, belonging to said Estate: hereby renouncing all right and claim forever by way of [?heirship] to and in the Premissess – Convenanting and Promising for ourselves, heirs, Execut^{re} and admin^s that said Eleazor Davis our Brother, his heirs and assigns shall and may forever hereafter by virtue of these presents Have, Hold, Use, improve and Enjoy the Premissess above- conveyed, our whole right and interest to and in the same which we now have or ever had, free and clear from the legal claim Demand contradiction or Denial of us [?orecther of us], our heirs, Execut^{rs}, Admin^{rs} or any other person whatsoever claiming the Same or any part thereof from by or under us by any way or means whatsoever In witness whereof we have set our hands and seals this fourth day of May AD 1748 and in the twenty first year of his Majesties Reign Signed, Sealed and Delivered

To all People to whom these Presents shall come Greeting Know Ye, that I Rebecca Davis of Bedford in the County of Middlesex, within His Majesties Province of the Massachusetts Bay in New England, Single Woman, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Pounds Old Tenor to me in Hand well and truly paid by my Brother Eleazar Davis of sd Bedford Yeoman, the Reciept whereof I do hereby acknowledge and myself therewith fully satisfied and contented, and Thereof, and of Every Part and Parcel Thereof, do Exonerate acquit and discharge Him the said Eleazar Davis, His Heirs, Executors and Administrators for ever by these Presents. Do hereby give, pass over and convey unto him the said Eleazar Davis His Heirs and Assigns forever, all my Interest, in the Village Right, or Right of Land in Acton, belonging to the Estate of our Hond Father Eleazar Davis late of Concord in sd County deceadd, and also give up, pass over and convey unto Him my said Brother Eleazar Davis, His Heirs and Assigns for Ever, Two Thirds of the Rest of the Real Estate of our Father Eleazar Davis Deceased, to which I had a right: Hereby for myself, my Heirs, Executors & Administrators, do Renounce all Right, Title, Claim and Interest to and in said Premises and Further I the said Rebecca Davis, for myself my Heirs, executors & Administrators do covenant & engage with the said Eleazar Davis, his Heirs, Executors & Administrators, that He the said Eleazar Davis, His Heirs & Assigns, shall for ever here after, Peaceably and Quietly Have Hold, Use, Improve and Enjoy siad Premises, free and clear from any other gift, sale or conveyance by me made or sufferend to be made; and without any legal claim or Demand Contradiction or Denial of me my Heirs, Executors, Administrators, or any other Person claiming from, by or under me. In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my Hand and Seal this Twenty First Day of May Anno Domini one Thousand Seven Hundred and Forty Eight. In the Twenty First Year of His Majesties Reign-----
