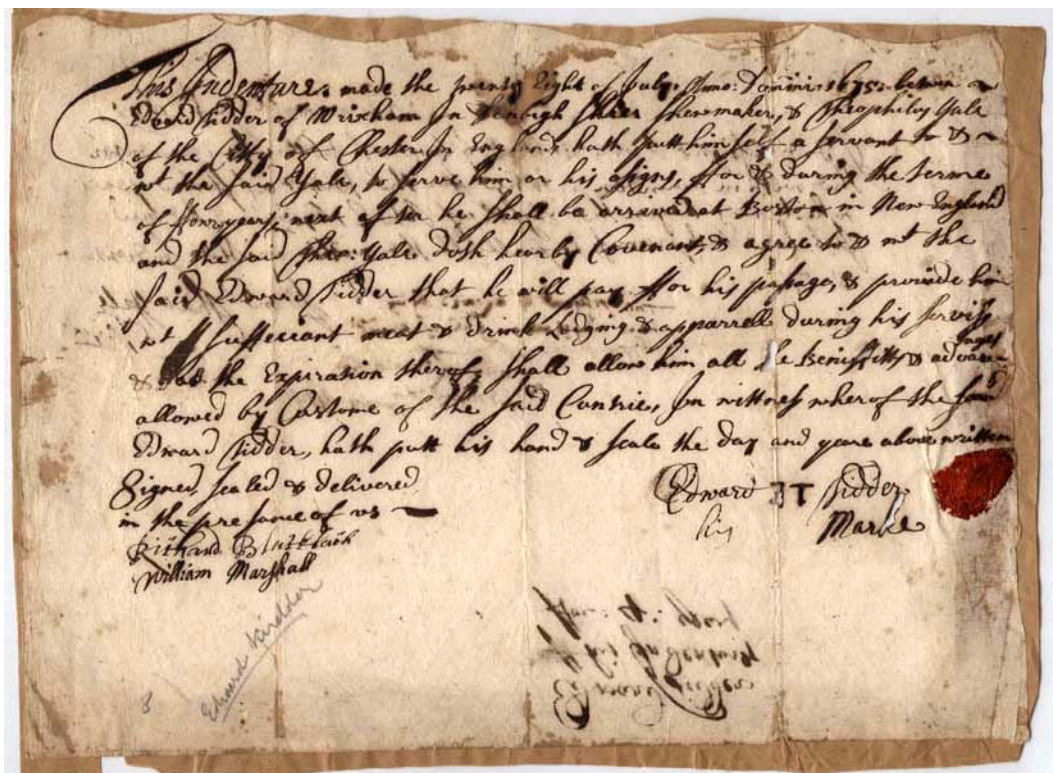


#220 July 8, 1675

Indenture between Edward Kidder and Theophilus Yale; transferred to Job Lane (I)



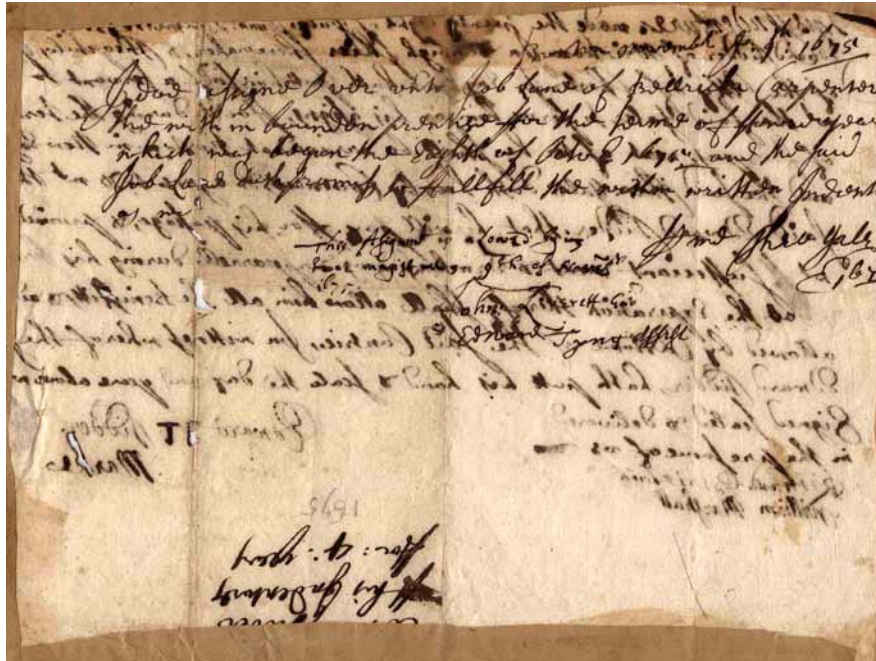
This Indenture made the twenty eight of July Anno Domini 1675 between Edward Kidder of Wrixham in Denbighshier shewmaker, & Theophilus Yale of the City of Chester In England hath putt himself a servant to & w<sup>th</sup> the said Yale, to serve him or his assigns, for and during the terme of four years, next after he shall be arrived at Boston in New England and the said Theo: Yale doth hearby covenant, & agree so & ? the said Edward Kidder that he will pay for his passage & provide him wt sufficient meat & drink, lodging & apparrell during his servise & at the Expiration thereof shall allow him all the benifittd & advantages allowed by Custome of the said Contrie, In wittness wherof the said Edward Kidder hath put his hand & seal the day and yeare above written
