Know all Men by These Presents That I Josiah Kidder of Tewsbury In y^e County of Middlesex in y^e Province of y^e Massachusetts Bay in New England Yeoman am Holden and Stand firmly bound and oblig'd Unto John Russel Jun^r of Andover In y^e County of Essex in y^e Province afore said Yeoman In y^e Full and Just Sum of one Hundred Pounds Lawful Money of New England To be Paid Unto him y^e said John Russel Jun^r or his Heirs Exec^{ts} or Admini^{trs} To y^e which Day I do well and Truly to be made Seeing my self my Heirs Executors and Admini^{trs} and each of them firmly by these Presents sealed with my Seal Dated this Thirteenth Day of November Anno Dom 1747 and in y^e Twenty first year of his Majesties Reign George y^e Second &c

The Condition of this Present Obligation is such that if y^e above Bounded Josiah Kidder or his Heirs Exec^{ts} or Admini^{trs} or any of them do well and Truly pay or cause to be Paid Unto him y^e said John Russel or his Heirs Exec^{ts} Admini^{trs} or assigns y^e Full and Just Sum of Fifty Pounds Current Passible Bills of Credit of y^e Province above said of y^e old Tenor or Equivalent in y^e new Emission with Lawful Interest for y^e same at or before the Thirteenth Day of May which shall be in y^e year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Forty Eight without Fraud Taven or Further Delay Then this obligation to be void and of none Effect or Else to Stand and Remain in full force & virtue
